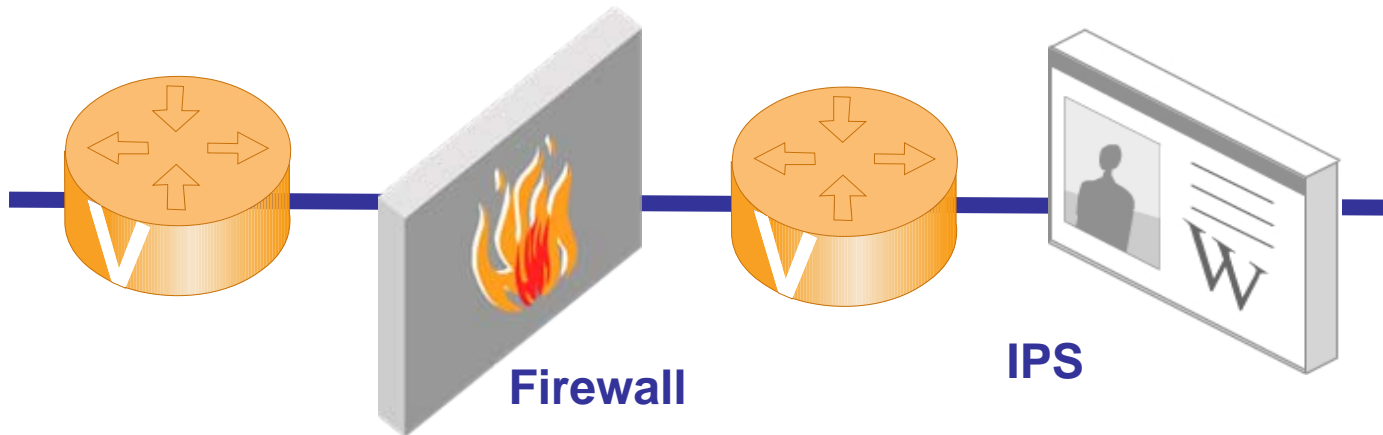
Today

- Gateway infrastructure is in place (clock ticking on 1 year contract)
- It has been accepted by JANET(UK)
- Traffic is passing for the early adopter sites – some diverted from N3 Internet Gateway and some “new”
- Sessions initiated in N3, “Any N3” thro “Any port” to early adopter IP addresses only
- Tandberg Expressway in place but not yet commissioned (for H.323 videoconferencing)



Physical gateway

- connect JANET backbone & N3 core



- single 100 Mbps interconnection in London



Delays

- Originally thought we would be here in May
- Main delays:
 - BT quotation
 - Switch from EES to Ethernet circuit
 - Switch from Proventia to McAfee IPS





But did give us more time for the Information Governance...



(NB England, Scotland different)

- Initially thought Memorandum of Understanding would be the way forward
- Then “Statement of Compliance” emerged
- SoC for JANET(UK) as the aggregator
- SoC for each University as an early adopter? Agreed not for the initial set up.....as long as no patient identifiable data (PID) involved.....

- JANET Videoconferencing Service (JVCS)
 - NHS studio access to HE (+ FE + schools ...) conferences running over JANET
